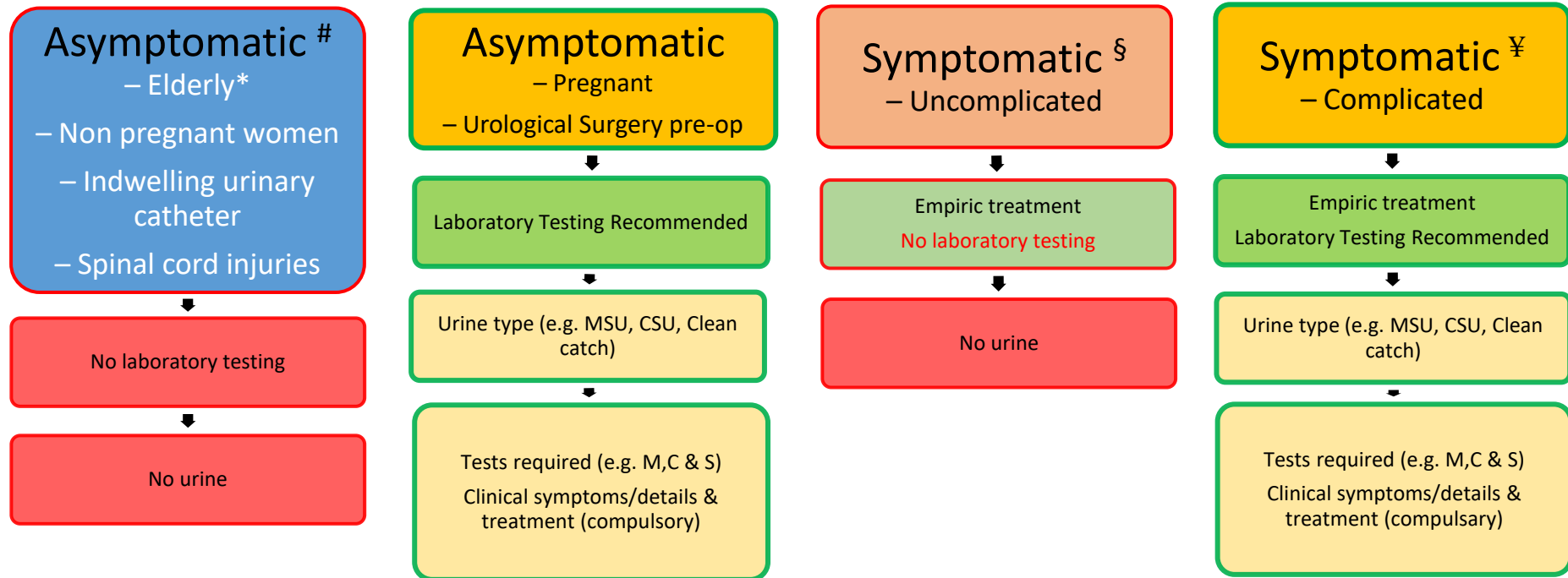


UTI Laboratory Testing Guide



Screening for asymptomatic bacteriuria is NOT recommended in this patient group. **DO NOT perform a dipstick urinalysis.**

The following are **NOT** symptoms of UTI and **NO urine test** is required:

- Smelly urine
- Cloudy urine
- Concentrated urine

§ Uncomplicated UTI - women:

- Classic presentation
- Normal urinary tract
- No recent instrumentation
- No complicating factors

¥ Complicated UTI:

- Men
- Children
- Pregnancy
- Pyelonephritis
- Treatment failure
- Hospital-acquired
- Immunocompromised
